# REMOTE INSTRUCTIONAL GUIDE



## North Arlington Public School District

During the 2021-2022 school year, students may be recommended to self-quarantine due to COVID19. In those instances, the North Arlington Public School District will provide remote instructional services for quarantined students. Please thoroughly review the expectations highlighted in this document. **Please Note:** Students who are not recommended to self-quarantine shall not be permitted to attend any classes remotely.

#### **Self-Quarantine Overview**

Teachers will follow an instructional check-in schedule throughout the school day. In order to facilitate remote instruction, all classrooms will continue the use of Google Meet within Google Classroom (PreK-12). Elementary students (PreK-5) and secondary students (6-12) will follow age-appropriate schedules, as noted within this document. The partnership between our schools and families is essential to the success of remote instruction.

### **Google Guardian**

Please check your email for a *Google Guardian* invitation. If you have not already received an invitation, you will receive one by Wednesday, September 22, 2021. *Google Guardian* will allow participating family members to receive updates directly from the Google Classroom.

#### **Pre-K- Grade 5 Guidelines**

- → There will be a minimum of 3 instructional mini-lessons per day, covering major subject areas.
  - A schedule for students to engage in Google Meets for live instruction will be posted daily in Google Classroom.
  - Students are expected to keep their cameras on during Google Meet sessions.
- → Once each mini-lesson is complete, asynchronous activities and assignments will be assigned in Google Classroom.
- → Asynchronous activities will be directly connected to in-person student learning objectives.
- → After school help will continue to be provided to all struggling learners, including remote students.
- → Specials will continue to take place within the Google Classroom, with as much remote student participation as possible.

#### **Grades 6-12 Guidelines**

- → Quarantined students will attend each class remotely at the start of every period, via a live Google Meet.
  - Students are expected to keep their cameras on during Google Meet sessions.
- → Teachers will deliver a live mini-lesson.
- → Once the lesson is complete, asynchronous activities will be assigned in Google Classroom for the remainder of the period.
- → Asynchronous activities will be directly connected to in-person student learning objectives.
- → The teacher may check in with students prior to the end of the period, as needed, in Google Classroom.
- → After school help will continue to be provided to all struggling learners, including remote students.
- → Specials will continue to take place within the Google Classroom, with as much remote student participation as possible.

#### **IEPs**

All students' IEPs will continue to be followed remotely. All specific questions should be directed to the Child Study Team (CST) and/or the Director of Special Education, Mr. Burke.

#### **Related Services**

The Director of Special Education and/or CST will coordinate any related-services for students who are learning remotely.
