O. MOTION TO APPROVE THE SUBMISSION OF THE FINAL 2017-2018 SCHOOL BUDGET

WHEREAS the North Arlington Board of Education is responsible for the preparation of an annual school budget that is to be submitted to the County Superintendent of Schools for her review; and

WHEREAS the North Arlington Board of Education has developed assumptions, constraints and priorities to guide the Board of Education, the Superintendent of Schools, and the Business Administrator in preparing a budget for the 2017-2018 school year; and

WHEREAS the North Arlington Board of Education has directed the Superintendent of Schools and the Business Administrator to prepare a budget for the 2017-2018 school year, using the guidelines established by the State Department of Education; and

WHEREAS the North Arlington Board of Education has deliberated on the budget that has been prepared by the authorized parties.

BE IT RESOLVED that the North Arlington Board of Education approves the submission of the final 2017-2018 school district budget for submission to the County Superintendent of Schools as follows:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the budget includes Banked Cap in the amount of \$579,258 in the General Fund Tax Levy, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 18A:7F-37. The amount of banked cap requested is only the amount used to increase the tax levy; and will be used to fund the additional costs for out of district tuition.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the use of Banked Cap cannot be deferred or incrementally completed over a longer period of time; and Banked Cap was discussed and adopted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the budget includes an health adjustment of \$146,438 for health benefits necessitated by increased costs, in its General Fund Tax Levy, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-10.3(b), the need for and the amount of the unused spending authority be included in the base budget.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board ratify and confirm the transfer of \$150,000 from Capital Projects I (Referendum Account) to Debt Service to reduce the debt service tax levy.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the North Arlington Board of Education authorizes the Superintendent of Schools and the Business Administrator to amend this budget to whatever degree necessary in order to meet State budgetary requirements and directives for submission to the County Office.
