H. RESOLUTION TO APPROVE SUSPENSION OF A STUDENT.

WHEREAS, formal disciplinary proceedings were initiated against a Student whose name is on file by the North Arlington Board of Education ("the Board") regarding allegations that in October 2014, the Student engaged in assault and harassment against a staff member in violation of Board Policies and Regulations Nos. 5520 (Disorder and Demonstration); 5600 (Pupil Discipline/Code of Conduct); 5610 (Suspension); 5612 (Assault by Pupils on Board Members or Employees); 5620 (Expulsion), and the North Arlington High School Student/Parent Handbook; and

WHEREAS, the Student and his parent were provided with notice of a due process hearing to be held on November 4, 2014, and of their right to be represented by counsel, to present evidence and witnesses on behalf of the Student, and of their right to cross-examine any and all witnesses presented by the Superintendent; and

WHEREAS, the Student was provided with a due process hearing on November 4, 2014, at which time the Student and the Student's parent appeared before the Superintendent; and

WHEREAS, the Superintendent reviewed documentary and testimonial evidence against the Student; the Student's parent presented testimony and arguments on the Student's behalf; and the Student testified on his own behalf; and

WHEREAS, the Board has considered all of the evidence, including witness statements and testimony, the Student's academic and disciplinary records, Board Policies and Regulations Nos. 5520 (Disorder and Demonstration); 5600 (Pupil Discipline/Code of Conduct); 5610 (Suspension); 5612 (Assault by Pupils on Board Members or Employees); 5620 (Expulsion), and the North Arlington High School Student/Parent Handbook;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- The Board hereby determines, based upon a preponderance of the competent and credible evidence, that in October 2014, the Student admittedly engaged in the act of assault and harassment against a staff member, in violation of the aforementioned policies, regulations, and statutes, and further determines that such conduct is grounds for discipline.
- 2. The Board hereby further determines that, in light of the serious nature of the conduct, and in accordance with *N.J.S.A.* 18A:37-5, the Student shall be removed from North Arlington High School (suspended) through the end of the school year.
- 3. The Board hereby further determines that the Student shall not be present on any of the Board's school campuses outside of or during the regularly scheduled school day during the period of his suspension, unless specifically authorized by the Superintendent.

- 4. The Board hereby further determines that the Student shall not be permitted to participate in any athletic, co-curricular and/or extra-curricular activities sponsored by the Board and shall not be present for or attend any Board sponsored activities (e.g., dances, proms, sporting events, graduation events such as "project graduation," or graduation ceremonies of any class) either on campus or in any school district where the District is participating in the activities during the period of suspension.
- 5. The Board hereby further determines that, during the period of his suspension from the North Arlington High School, the Student shall be provided with an alternative educational program, pursuant to State and federal laws, that meets the Core Curriculum Standards in accordance with *N.J.A.C.* 6A:8-1.1 *et seq.*
- 6. The Board hereby further determines that further engagement by the Student in conduct warranting expulsion pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 18A:37-2 and/or failure to comply with any of the aforementioned terms and conditions shall amount to a knowing and voluntary waiver of the Student's right to a free and appropriate public education in the event that a decision to expel the Student is made by the Board pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 18A:37-2 and *N.J.A.C.* 6A:16-7.5.
