IV. STATEMENT OF PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE

Motion to go into Executive Session at 6:00 pm made by Mr. Smith, second by Mrs. Higgins. There was no discussion. On Roll Call all Board Members present voted in the affirmative and none in the negative, it was so ordered.

1. Mr. Dorsett inquired about the ratification of the association contract. The Superintendent addressed his inquiry.
