

Getting Started with your North Arlington Chromebook


North Arlington School District currently uses Acer Chromebook devices as part of our 'One to One' initiative. Please keep the following information for your reference.

We've taken care to make sure each previously used device that comes in has been wiped with antibacterial cleaner, and reset to default specifications before redistribution.

You will receive your device with a case/cover. It is recommended that your device stays in the case/cover while not in use or during transportation.

Connect your Chromebook to Wi-Fi

To connect to the Internet, use a compatible Wi-Fi network.

1. At the bottom right, select the time.
2. Select Not Connected .
Note: If you see your Wi-Fi network name and a signal strength, your Chromebook is already connected to Wi-Fi.
3. Turn on Wi-Fi.
4. Your Chromebook will automatically look for available networks and show them to you in a list.
5. Select your WiFi network and enter the appropriate network password when prompted.
6. Click Connect when ready.

Logging into your Chromebook

Once connected to your wifi home network, please log in with your provided username and password. Generally it is the **first four of the first name** and the **first three of the last name** with **@navikings.org**.

For Example: Joseph Smith would be josesmi@navikings.org

Note: There are some exceptions to this rule as there are names with similar spellings and may have the same username. In that instance please contact your school for more information if you are having difficulty logging in.

The current student temporary password is **student2020**.

Note: This is temporary and you will be prompted to change it upon successful login. It is recommended to NOT use this as your permanent password due to security reasons.
